The Nebraska Office of Highway Safety is sponsoring a grant for The Kearney Police Department for Selective Alcohol Overtime Enforcement. This selective enforcement will be conducted July 15 & 16, 2017 in conjunction with Cruise Nite Weekend. Officers will be out in force, cracking down on Alcohol Violations such as Minor in Possession (53-180.01), Open Container (60-6,2211.08), Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs (60-6196) Minor DUI (60-6211.01). The Grant will pay up to \$7,200.00 in Overtime for the project.

As always, the Kearney Police Department is requesting that you obey the Nebraska Alcohol laws. Be Safe. Be Smart. Cruise Nite 2017.

We would also like to remind everyone that the Downtown area needs to be cleared of vehicles by 2 a.m. on July 15 or the vehicles will be towed. The areas to be cleared are: Central Avenue from 25th Street to North Railroad Street, 24th Street from Avenue A to 1st Avenue, 23rd Street from Avenue A to 1st Avenue, and 21st Street from Avenue A to 1st Avenue to stage vehicles for display. The parking lot west of Cunningham's Journal, the parking lot north of City Hall, and the parking lot north of MONA will also be closed. The event for display will begin at 8:00 a.m. on July 15. All vehicles will be removed from the downtown area after 2:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 15 to facilitate staging vehicles for the event.
