Yanney Park Lake Fish Restocking

The Kearney Park and Recreation Department is pleased to announce that the lake at Yanney Park received about 715 pounds of Donaldson Strain Rainbow Trout on Thursday, October 19, 2017. The fish are a gift by Mr. Michael Yanney and came from the Pleasant Valley Fish Farm with prior approval of the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission Fisheries Division. All State fishing regulations apply and Nebraska Fishing Permits are required. All of the new fish stocked are 16" and over. Practicing catch and release and fish friendly handling techniques for release can greatly extend the value of this remarkable resource. Using barbless single hooks, limiting the amount of time the fish is out of the water, and holding a fish upright in the water while it revives to swim away can all help with the survival of caught and released fish.
