Hike/Bike Trail Alert

The City of Kearney and BD Construction would like to alert users of the hike/bike trail that dewatering is taking place at Speedee Mart on the southwest corner of Talmadge and 2nd Avenue. Water is being moved via pipe to the southeast, crossing under 2nd Avenue. This has made for standing water covering the hike/bike trail at the southeast corner of Talmadge Street and 2nd Avenue. The contractor will be pumping water off the trail intermittently throughout the course of the project. This dewatering process is expected to take place until September 20, pending unforeseen delays. Please exhibit caution when approaching any submerged part of the trail.
