Recycle Christmas String Lights and Batteries

Upgrading your Christmas tree lights? Maybe you have some old strings of lights that just don't work anymore? Now, old and unwanted Christmas string lights can be recycled at the Household Hazardous Waste drop-off, 3620 Box Butte Avenue. These lights will be accepted through the end of January 2020.

Also, please remember that the City of Kearney accepts used and unwanted batteries from Kearney households. Dry Cell Batteries such as AA, AAA, C and D batteries can be recycled at the Household Hazardous Waste drop-off, as well as Ace Hardware and Tractor Supply. Lead acid batteries, such as car batteries, can be dropped off at the landfill or at the Kearney Area Recycling Center year-round.
