Street Closure/Asphalt Milling & Overlay: North Railroad Street, 1st Avenue, 21st Street, 22nd Street, 23rd Street and 24th Street

The City of Kearney Public Works Department and Blessing Construction announce that the following streets will be closed for asphalt milling and overlay - North Railroad Street will be closed from Central Avenue to 5th Avenue on Monday, September 21, 2020 beginning at 6:00 a.m. 1st Avenue will be closed from 21st Street to 24th Street on Tuesday, September 22, 2020 beginning at 6:00 a.m. After 1st Avenue milling is completed the street will be reopened to traffic until the asphalt overlay construction is ready to begin. 21st Street, from 1st Avenue to 2nd Avenue, 22nd Street from Central Avenue to 150' West of 1st Avenue, 23rd Street from 1st Avenue to 2nd Avenue & 24th Street from Central Avenue to 2nd Avenue, will be closed at various times beginning Tuesday, September 22, 2020 to Thursday September 24, 2020. After the street milling is completed the street will be reopened to traffic until the asphalt overlay construction is ready to begin. All vehicles will need to be removed from the street prior to any construction. Citizens are urged to be mindful of construction activities while they are in the downtown area.
