### **5th Avenue Railroad Crossing Update**

The City of Kearney Public Works Department announces that beginning Monday, September 28 as part of the Union Pacific Rail Road protocols, locomotives may periodically sound their horns at the 5th Avenue crossing until Friday, October 2. This is in preparation to remove the wayside directional horns in order to switch over to the Quiet Zone. It should be noted that engineers will blow the train horn at their discretion at any time should they see anything of concern.
