Construction Work: Antelope Avenue and 39th Street

The City of Kearney on behalf of Blessing Construction announces that construction of roadway improvements on Antelope Avenue will begin Thursday, March 4, 2021. North and south bound traffic will be closed on Antelope Avenue at 39th Street on the south side of the intersection for approximately 100 feet. Access to properties will be made through the remaining side streets. Work will include roadway removal, grading activities, as well as new paving. Future traffic changes will be implemented as the project progresses and notification of these changes issued at that time. Work is scheduled to take approximately 2 weeks for this phase, pending weather unknown delays. Citizens are urged to use caution near the work zone.
