### **June 2021 Priority Traffic Enforcement Area - Results**

During the month of June, Officers completed 44 hours of increased enforcement efforts on the Priority Traffic Enforcement Area of Traffic Signal Violations throughout the entire city.

Officers had a total of 167 traffic contacts for a variety of violations to include 9 Speed, 41 Traffic Signal Violation, 80 Improper Turns, and 37 others. All violations which are a common contributing factor in vehicle crashes. A total of 150 warnings and 17 traffic citations were issued.

The ultimate goal of these enforcement areas is to reduce the number of vehicle collisions at high traffic volume intersections and roadways throughout the city. We encourage motorists to drive safely, obey speed limits, traffic control devices, avoid distraction, and wear your seatbelts.
