Tire Disposal Fees Reinstated

The Kearney Area Solid Waste Agency Landfill had secured a grant from the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality Scrap Tire Reduction Fund. This grant allowed the landfill to accept up to 325 tons of tires free of charge from the residents of Buffalo County. The tire collection event began March 8 and was scheduled to end March 11, 2022 or until the 325 tons was reached. The landfill had a tremendous response on the first day of the event, reaching its grant totals. The landfill will end this free disposal of tires on **Tuesday, March 8. Normal landfill disposal fees will be reinstated then.**

The Kearney Area Solid Waste Agency Landfill would like to thank the residents of Buffalo County who took advantage of the free tire disposal. The landfill has now collected over 2,899.7 tons of tires from tire collection events funded by the NDEQ scrap tire grant.
