1st Avenue – From Railroad Street to 25th Street – Traffic Signal Evaluation

Citizens should be advised that the City of Kearney is evaluating the intersections on 1st Avenue from Railroad Street to 25th Street to improve traffic flow along this segment of roadway. Effective Wednesday, March 30, 2022 the traffic signals at the intersections of 1st Avenue and 21st Street, 1st Avenue and 23rd Street, and 1st Avenue and 24th Street will be operated in red flash mode thus creating a four-way stopped intersection in all directions. These intersections will operate in this manner until further notice.
