## **Closure of Downtown Streets for Shrine Bowl Parade**

The City of Kearney announces that the annual Shrine Bowl Parade is scheduled for June 4, 2022. This will entail the closing of the following streets beginning at 6:00 a.m. for staging purposes:

- 1st Avenue from 24th Street to Railroad Street
- Central Avenue from 24th Street to Railroad Street
- Railroad Street from Avenue E to 5th Avenue
- 3rd Avenue and 4th Avenue from Railroad Street to 22nd Street
- Avenues C and D from Railroad Street to 22nd Street

The parade route will begin at 11:00 a.m. at the corner of Central Avenue and Railroad Street, north on Central Avenue to 24th Street, west on 24th Street to 1st Avenue, and south on 1st Avenue back to Railroad Street.
