Cherry Avenue Hike/Bike Trail Pedestrian Bridge Closure

The City of Kearney Public Works Department and Diamond Engineering would like to inform the public that warranty repairs required on the Cherry Avenue pedestrian bridge will begin Wednesday, January 20, 2021. During this time the bridge will be closed to pedestrian traffic. The repairs are expected to be completed by Friday, February 12, 2021.

During this time the trail sections east and west of the bridge will remain open for use and can be accessed by the nearby parking areas. Citizens are asked to use caution while in the area of construction.
