STEPS TO A SUCCESSFUL LANDSCAPE



Determine Goal & Location

Whether your goal is to install a few native plants, or convert part of your landscape, make sure your registered landscape is located on private property and outside of the right-of-way and vision clearance triangle at intersections and driveways to protect pedestrians.

Registration

Yearly registration is required for landscapes to be able to follow the current [Native Landscape Policy](#). Visit our website or contact Development Services for an [application](#) and to schedule delivery of your sign.



Maintain

Landscapes with native plants require less water and fertilizer than conventional lawns because they are adapted to local environmental conditions. However, some maintenance is required to help your landscape look intentional. Kearney residents are counting on each other to maintain property values, so be sure to be a good neighbor and follow the management tips from the resources provide.
